### ITEMS NEEDED BY November 7, end of day.

### Truck leaves Nazareth, PA on November 10

ALL items packed in the truck must be in plastic bins/totes/containers labeled. Most have no homes and are either living with others or searching for tents/shelter. Anything they pick up has to be carried as all most vehicles are gone.

The town business association that is coordinating this direct relief efforts also run a country café and is making food non stop for all those who need food. Some of the items are for this café so they can continue to serve as many as possible on a daily basis.

### **NEEDED:**

Benedryl, Epi Pens (Even expired ones) Eye Drops

Hot hands hand and foot warmers

Camp Showers Camp Toilets

NEW Tents NEW Sleeping Bags NEW sheet sets

New blankets

Small Propane stoves, cooking grills

Plastic totes with lids (must be easy to carry!!! No large ones that are too heavy to carry when full!)

### **FOOD ITEMS:**

Spam, Soups and Stews in cans with pop top lids. Please NO condensed soup that you have to add water to! There is no clean water in many areas!!!

Take out food containers Silverware (the ones that are packaged in plastic bags with salt/pepper)

NO CEREAL PLEASE! They do not have milk/bowls spoons!

Ziplock Bags (gallon size or larger)

Granola Bars/Breakfast Bars/Fruit Snacks/Protein Bars

**MREs** 

Dried Fruit/Dried Food/Trail Mix/Survival Type Food

Drink mixes that can be easily added to a bottle of water (NO LARGE CANS ACCEPTED)

Bread and biscuit mixes, pancake mix that you just add water too

Immersion blenders

Pet Food for dogs/horses/cats Livestock Feed

Solar phone chargers

Battery operated flashlights/lanterns WITH BATTERIES (Remember, there is no electricity)

First Aid Kits

Feminine Hygiene products

Backpacks (Most are walking and need to carry everything with them)

Anything that requires cooking/opening with a can opener/will need refrigeration or that needs electricity to prepare

### CLOTHING IS BEING ACCEPTED AT THIS POINT

Please note that ALL items including bedding MUST be separated by NEW AND USED. Do not co-mingle new and used items in the same bag!

Sweatshirts/Jackets in all sizes

Winter clothes

NEW winter hats/gloves/scarves

Please use the following to label the bags when you drop them off if you don't have masking tape to label the bags (This way they know at collection sites this is for Hurricane Relief and not a Scout Clothing Drive) Print this out and then use clear packing tape to tape the labels to the bags.

NOTE: Every bag must have the red EVERY RIBBON COUNTS LABEL and either NEW OR USED in addition to what is in the bag.

Hopefully, these labels will make things easier for you.
