**Construction Tools**

**Trash Bags, construction style**

Benedryl, Epi Pens (Even expired ones)

Granola Bars/Breakfast Bars/Fruit Snacks/Protein Bars

Drink mixes that can be easily added to a bottle of water (NO LARGE CANS ACCEPTED)

All food donated MUST be in cans with Pop top lids. Can openers are not available there

Ziplock Bags (gallon size or larger)

Bread and biscuit mixes, pancake mix that you just add water too

Boots in all sizes New socks for all ages

Sweatshirts/Jackets in all sizes Especially XXL and XXXL

Pet Food for dogs/horses/cats/Livestock Feed

Battery operated flashlights/lanterns WITH BATTERIES (Remember, there is no electricity)

First Aid Kits

Home Depot Buckets/Lowes Buckets WITH LIDS

Hygiene products for all ages

Diapers and pull ups in sizes 6, 7, 8

Laundry Detergent

Cleaning Supplies, Windex, Sponges

Paper Products

Dried Fruit/Dried Food/Trail Mix/Survival Type Food

Backpacks (Most are walking and need to carry everything with them)
